Throughout the year, the Diocese of North America and Europe, through the Mar Thoma Mission Board, which is a registered tax-exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, could engage meaningfully in various mission activities. The vision of the Mission Board is to reach out to those in need with the love of Christ with the aim of bringing about transformation in the lives of individuals and communities. The Mar Thoma Mission Board coordinates the five mission initiatives of the Diocese – Native American Mission, Mexico Mission, Neighborhood Mission, India Mission, and Light to Life.

This year, four VBS camps were arranged during the summer months in Oklahoma, Alabama, New Mexico, and Louisiana through our Native American Mission (NAM). Also, seventeen deserving Native American college students were awarded with academic scholarships through the NAM Higher Education Scholarship program. The Colonia Mar Thoma community in our Mexico Mission was provided with monthly food provisions through the Manna Program, and spiritual edification was provided through regular worship services. For the first time, an Annual Convention was conducted in addition to VBS and medical camps. Through the Light to Life mission program, support is provided for the education and holistic development of over 4,500 children in different parts of India. Many of our parishes were actively involved in Neighborhood Mission by identifying and supporting the needs of local communities. Our involvement through the various mission endeavors of the Diocese has made a visible impact in the lives of many people. It is with the committed vision and dedicated services of our laity and clergy that all our mission activities are progressing well.

The Diocese has set apart **Sunday, November 20, 2022** for prayer and participation in our mission programs through ***Suvishesha Nidhi Offering***. We urge all members to wholeheartedly contribute to the mission activities of the Diocese. The Vicars, Office Bearers, and Diocesan Assembly Members are requested to make necessary arrangements and are to encourage parishioners to donate generously for the mission activities through the Suvishesha Nidhi Offering. Special offertory envelopes will be distributed.
